### **BOOTHS MUST BE SET UP AND READY FOR BUSINESS BY 9:30 A.M.**

Vehicles *must* be out of the event area by 9:00 a.m. NO vehicles will be permitted into the Poochapalooza area until after 4:00 p.m. (vehicles will be allowed in the Poochapalooza festival area as soon as the Poochapalooza Coordinator deems it safe depending upon the remaining crowd). Vehicles can unload and load from on the running track, but must stay off the football field grass. Distance to actual booth space is minimal, and volunteers will assist you to locate and get situated in your space conveniently. The rules are in keeping with Poochapalooza safety policies and practices, and protecting the Marysville School District field. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.

Event Officials will hold onto any items left at the end of the day Saturday. If you find at a later time that vendor items belonging to you are missing, please contact us to claim those items and we'll arrange to get them returned to you.
